


What we offer

Do not pass urine for 2 hours before testing.



Pregnancy Testing.



Referral for termination of pregnancy



Emergency Contraception



Immunisation for Hepatitis B



Tablets for HIV – up to 72 hours following possible sexual exposure (including rape)
